

Procedure to Object to or Support of the Settlement Agreement

A Settlement Hearing will be held in Courtroom 4A of the Montgomery County Courthouse on Monday, June 20, 2011 at 1:00 PM.

PACT purchasers will receive formal notice of the Settlement Hearing by a mailed postcard. Any PACT purchaser or beneficiary may appear at the hearing, in person or by counsel, and be heard if he or she has first filed a written objection with the Circuit Clerk. No purchaser or beneficiary will be allowed to object on behalf of another purchaser or beneficiary, or if no written objection is timely filed in advance.

The process for filing an objection is set out in detail by the Preliminary Approval of Proposed Settlement entered by the Court on May 5, 2011, a copy of which is available on the PACT website. In general terms, the objection process is summarized as follows:

1. File a written objection no later than June 10, 2011.
2. The objection may be in support of, or in opposition to, any matter pertaining to the Settlement Agreement.
3. Each objection must contain:
 - a. A short, plain statement of reasons for the objection
 - b. Reference to Case No: CV-2010-900013
 - c. The name, address and signature of the current PACT owner
 - d. The name of the current PACT beneficiary
 - e. The date the PACT Contract was purchased
 - f. Any supporting documentation for the objection
